Benefits of Futsal

Technical/Tactical

Lots of opportunities as an individual and within a team for players to practice dribbling, passing, controlling, finishing, moving without the ball and defending, with combination play

Psychological

The demands of the game via the components and the rules, in a competitive environment, means players confidence, decision making, emotional control and fortitude is constantly challenged and tested



Physical

When players are on court they are always involved in the play and need to be constantly moving at different speeds and in different directions

Social

On the court, futsal is clearly a team game by nature, but due to the unlimited substitutions and numerous changes in both personnel and game scenario, the group as a whole is tested throughout



League information

LOCATION

The league will be played at two courts inside <u>Repton</u> <u>School (Fry campus)</u>

The League reserves the right to schedule any matches at either court.

SPECTATOR POSITIONING

Where there are viewing galleries, spectators are encouraged to watch the matches from that point. On courts where there are no viewing galleries, spectators will be assigned viewing positions. Please adhere to this for the safety and enjoyment of the players.







League rules

- 5 players on each team 1 player designated as goalkeeper.
- Play area to lines kick-ins for all restarts. No throw ins from the sidelines.
- When the attacking team puts the ball over the goal line, the goalkeeper must put the ball back into play with a throw, roll or kick, within 4 seconds.
- Goalkeeper cannot kick from hands.
- A goalkeeper can only be in possession of the ball once, in their own half, per every possession of play and they have 4 seconds to play. No limitations when they are in possession of the ball in opposition half.
- Any infringements of the above rules, an indirect free kick will result from the area of infringement or from the penalty line.
- A throw from the goalkeeper must bounce in their own half or touch a player before entering the opposite half or an indirect free kick from the halfway line will ensue
- Substitutions will only be allowed in the designated Substitution area.
- The substitute only enters the pitch after the player being replaced has left the playing area.





League rules

- There are 4 seconds for all restarts an indirect freekick from the infringement point is given, or the balls is given to the opposition team if a kick in from the sides, if the 4 second rule is not observed,
- 5 metre distances for the opposition on restarts
- Rolling substitutions can substitute at any time. Oncoming players must only come on via the substitute area and as the exiting player leaves the court
- No slide tackles are allowed
- The offside rule does not apply
- All penalties must be one-step penalties. The player may only take one step before shooting the ball. If a goal is not scored, the player who kicked the ball must not play it again until it has been touched by another player. The ball shall be deemed in play directly after it is kicked and moves forward.
- Two yellow cards will comprise of one red card or a direct red can be given, depending upon the nature of the foul.
- If a player receives a red card, he can be replaced with another player but after two minutes. In those two minutes, the offending player's team will play with one player less.
- The dismissed player can no longer take part in the same game but can play the next game, unless the dismissal is for a violent offence in which case the organisers will decide the next steps.



Age verification

AGE CHECKS AND REGISTRATION

Under 10 - born 2015/16 Under 12 - born 2013/14 Under 14 - born 2011/12 all from January 1

Players will need to show an original or soft copy of Emirates ID when requested so coaches should ensure a copy is always with them or the player.

Age check requests can only be made via the organisers.

A 100aed deposit must be paid by the complainant in the case of any age checks. If the complainant is proved right, their money is returned. If the complainant is wrong and the player in question is within the right age, they forfeit that deposit.

Any team with an ineligible player will forfeit the game 3-0.





Matchday considerations

SQUAD LISTS

Teams can submit a maximum of twelve players per squad. Teams will have to submit a squad list. Once submitted, these squads cannot be changed for the duration of the league.

MATCH TIMING

Group matches will last for 2x20 minutes with a 5 minute half time.

BALL SIZE

Futsal has one size, a reduced bounce size 4 ball.









Matchday considerations

DETERMINING WINNERS

The team with the most points at the round of fixtures will be crowned the league winners.

League placing will be determined by the teams with the most points.

If two or more teams finish with the same number of points, their final group standing will be decided in the following order:

- Head to head
- Goals scored
- Goal difference
- Penalty shoot-out







Respect and safety

ARRIVALS AND LATENESS

Teams must arrive a minimum of 10 minutes prior to their kick off time for any ID checks and to be ready to kick off on time. Any team that is not ready to play or late after the 5th minute of kick off time will forfeit the game. 3-0. The match can still be played but it will be classed as a friendly.

SAFETY

Shin pads is recommended for all players.

Players must wear indoor shoes or plastic, flat moulded boots. Players with football boots/studs will not be permitted to play.

Players MUST always check to ensure shoelaces are tied and off the ground.







Code of Conduct

Teams are responsible for the conduct of all spectators.

Inappropriate conduct can result in a points deduction or a team's exclusion from the League and future competitions.

Spectators must view matches form the designated spectator areas only.

Coaches are responsible for managing their own spectators.

Players, coaches and spectators must show respect to the officials at all times. They are there to facilitate games for your players so please respect their time.
